



TRNT Stewards Inquiry Terry Treichel 18 December 2020

Venue – Alice Springs Turf Club

Stewards today opened an inquiry into a report relating to the alleged betting activities involving NT licenced jockey Terry Treichel. After taking evidence and reviewing betting statements from multiple corporate bookmakers, jockey Terry Treichel was charged under the provisions of AR 115(1)(a) which states:

AR115 Jockey and apprentice jockey misconduct

(1) A jockey or apprentice jockey must not:

(e) Bet, or have any interest in a bet, on any race or contingency relating to thoroughbred racing involving a race in which he or she is riding.

Terry Treichel was not required to enter a plea as Stewards are continuing to investigate this matter and other potentially related integrity issues.

Given the serious nature of the charge, Stewards acting under the provisions of AR23(a) have suspended the licence of jockey Terry Treichel forwith pending the hearing and the determination of this charge.

AR23: Without limiting any other rules or Stewards' powers, if a person has been charged with a breach of the Rules or with the commission of an indictable criminal offence, and if the Stewards are of the opinion that the continued participation of that person in racing might pose an unacceptable risk of prejudicing the image, interests, integrity or welfare of racing, the Stewards may pending the hearing and determination of the charge:

(a) suspend any licence, registration, right or privilege, granted to that person under these Australian Rules;
