2yo INSPECTIONS ON RACEDAY

All two year old horses engaged to race are required to be inspected by the Raceday Veterinary Officer as soon as they arrive on course to ascertain soundness to compete.

This process must be completed prior to the commencement of betting on the given race.

Any two-year-old examined and diagnosed as being shin sore will be withdrawn by the Stewards acting under the provisions of AR64D.

In the event of a horse being withdrawn from its engagement under this rule, every endeavour should be made to have the trainer of their representative present for the veterinary examination.
